## SENATE BILL 1219 RATIFIED BILL

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF REVENUE CREDITED TO THE DRY-CLEANING SOLVENT CLEANUP FUND THAT MAY BE USED TO PAY COSTS OF ASSESSMENT OR REMEDIATION OF DRY-CLEANING SOLVENT CONTAMINATION THAT OCCURRED PRIOR TO 1 JULY 2001, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2.(c) of S.L. 2001-265 reads as rewritten: "**SECTION 2.(c)** The total of all payments made pursuant to this section in a single fiscal year shall not exceed ten percent (10%) twenty-five percent (25%) of the revenues credited to the Dry-Cleaning Solvent Cleanup Fund in the preceding fiscal year."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective 1 July 2004.
