5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 143-318.14A(b) reads as rewritten:
7	"(b) Reasonable public notice of all meetings of commissions, committees, and
8	standing subcommittees of the General Assembly shall be given. For purposes of this
9	subsection, "reasonable public notice" includes, but is not limited to:
10	(1) Notice given openly at a session of the Senate or of the House; or
11	(2) Notice posted on the press room door of the State Legislative Building
12	in Raleigh and delivered or sent by electronic mail to the Legislative
13	Services Office. Office, and the following actions taken by the
14	appropriate legislative staff:
15	a. <u>Posting on the General Assembly web site;</u>
16	b. Sending notice by electronic mail to the legislative press
17	accounts on the General Assembly domain; and
18	<u>c.</u> <u>Sending notice by electronic mail to those who have requested</u>
19	notice by electronic mail.
20	G.S. 143-318.12 shall not apply to meetings of commissions, committees, and
21	standing subcommittees of the General Assembly."
22	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective 30 days after it becomes law.

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
