| 7 | Department of Health and Human Services from the Council members. The chair shall |
| 8 | hold this office for not more than four years. |
| 9 | (d) The Council shall meet quarterly and at other times at the call of the chair. A |
| 10 | majority of the Council shall constitute a quorum. |
| 11 | (e) Council members shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the |
| 12 | performance of their duties in accordance with G.S. 138-5 and G.S. 138-6, as |
| 13 | applicable. |
