The Board of Trustees shall consist of: 8 9 (1) The mayor of the four cities within the service area that have the 10 largest population, or a member of the city council designated by the city council to serve in the absence of the mayor. 11 12 (2) Two members of the Board of Transportation appointed by the Secretary of Transportation, to serve as ex officio nonvoting members. 13 14 (3) The chair of each Metropolitan Planning Organization or a member of 15 the Metropolitan Planning Organization designated 16 Metropolitan Planning Organization in the territorial jurisdiction. The 17 chair of the Metropolitan Planning Organization may appoint the Chair of the Transportation Advisory Committee, or a designee approved by 18 the Transportation Advisory Committee, as his or her designee. 19 20 **(4)** The chair of the board of commissioners of any county within the territorial jurisdiction or a member of the board of commissioners 21 22 designated by the board to serve in the absence of the chair, but only if 23 the Board of Trustees by resolution has expanded the Board of Trustees to include the chair of the board of commissioners of that 24 county and the board of commissioners of that county has consented 25 by resolution. 26 27 (5) The chair of the principal airport authority or airport commission of each of the two most populous counties within the territorial 28

jurisdiction, as determined by the most recent decennial federal census.

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1	The chair of the airport authority or airport commission may appoint a
2	designee. The designee is not required to be a member of the airport
3	authority or airport commission."
4	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
