SECTION 3. At its first meeting after this act becomes law, the Wildlife 1 Resources Commission shall initiate rule making to implement provisions of this act to 2 3 regulate dog training. Until the rules become effective, persons may participate in dog training activities for retrievers and bird dogs as permitted by G.S. 113-291.1(d1), as 4 amended by this act, using shotguns and nontoxic shot of #4 size or smaller and using 5 6 only domestically propagated waterfowl and game birds that have been obtained and marked as currently set forth in 15A NCAC 10B.0114. 7 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law. 8
