JUDGE IN DISTRICT COURT DISTRICT 15B.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

41 **SECTION 2.** The additional district court judge for District 15B authorized
 42 by this act shall be elected in the 2006 general election for a four-year term
 43 commencing on the first Monday in December 2006.

1 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
2 Department the sum of eighty-six thousand five hundred sixty-seven dollars (\$86,567)
3 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the new district court judge for District Court
4 District 15B authorized by this act.

5 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2006.
