1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PERMIT TEACHER ASSISTANTS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN
3	TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS TO CONTINUE TO WORK WHILE
4	THEY COMPLETE THEIR STUDENT TEACHING.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. Article 20 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended
7	by adding a new section to read:
8	"§ 115C-310. Teacher assistants engaged in student teaching.
9	The State Board of Education shall adopt a program to facilitate the process by
10	which teacher assistants may become teachers.
11	Teacher assistants who participate in this program:
12	(1) Shall be enrolled in an approved teacher education program in a North
13	Carolina institution of higher education; and
14	(2) Shall be employed in a North Carolina public school.
15	Local school administrative units are encouraged to assign teacher assistants to a
16	different classroom during student teaching than the classroom they are assigned to as a
17	teacher assistant. To the extent possible, they may be assigned to another school within
18	the same local school administrative unit.
19	At the discretion of the local school administrative unit, teacher assistants may
20	continue to receive their salary and benefits while student teaching in the same local
21	school administrative unit where they are employed as a teacher assistant.
22	The State Board of Education shall consult with the Board of Governors of The
23	University of North Carolina and the North Carolina Independent Colleges and
24	Universities in the development of the program. Each approved teacher education
25	program and each local school administrative unit shall administer this program
26	beginning with the 2005-2006 academic year."
27	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
