## HOUSE BILL 143 RATIFIED BILL

## AN ACT TO EXEMPT AGRI-TOURISM ACTIVITIES FROM THE PRIVILEGE TAX ON AMUSEMENTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 105-40 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(12) All farm-related exhibitions, shows, attractions, or amusements offered on land used for bona fide farm purposes as defined in G.S. 153A-340."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 1999, and applies to activities occurring on or after that date.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2006.
