3 (18) 'Motor vehicle oil filter' means a filter that removes impurities from
4 the oil used to lubricate an internal combustion engine in a motor
5 vehicle.

6 ...

7 (22a) 'Plastic bottle' means a plastic container that has a neck smaller than
8 the body of the container, accepts a screw top, snap cap, or other
9 closure and has a capacity of less than five gallons.

10 ...

11 (44a) 'Wooden pallet' means a wooden object consisting of a flat or
12 horizontal deck or platform supported by structural components that is
13 used as a base for assembling, stacking, handling, and transporting
14 goods."

15 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 130A-309.10(f) reads as rewritten:

16 "(f) No person shall knowingly dispose of the following solid wastes in landfills:

17 (1) Repealed by Session Laws 1991, c. 375, s. 1.

18 (2) Used oil.

19 (3) Yard trash, except in landfills approved for the disposal of yard trash
20 under rules adopted by the Commission. Yard trash that is source
21 separated from solid waste may be accepted at a solid waste disposal
22 area where the area provides and maintains separate yard trash
23 composting facilities.

24 (4) White goods.

25 (5) Antifreeze (ethylene glycol).

26 (6) Aluminum cans.

27 (7) Whole scrap tires, as provided in G.S. 130A-309.58(b). The
28 prohibition ~~against landfilling on disposal of whole tires in landfills~~
29 applies to all whole pneumatic rubber coverings, but does not apply to
30 whole solid rubber coverings.

31 (8) Lead-acid batteries, as provided in G.S. 130A-309.70.

32 (9) Electronic devices.

33 (10) Clean wood waste.

34 (11) Motor vehicle oil filters.

35 (12) Plastic bottles.

36 (13) Wooden pallets."

37 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 130A-309.10 is amended by adding a new subsection to
38 read:

39 "(k) A county or city may petition the Department for a waiver from the
40 prohibition on disposal of a material described in subdivisions (9), (10), (11), (12), and
41 (13) of subsection (f) of this section in a landfill based on a showing that prohibiting the
42 disposal of the material would constitute an economic hardship based on the absence of
43 a market for the material."

44 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
