Impaired driving after a conviction of impaired driving which was a proximate cause of traffic-related death. 10 Any person convicted of G.S. 20-138.1 or G.S. 20-138.2, after having been 11 previously convicted of a violation of G.S. 20-138.1 or G.S. 20-138.2 where the prior 12 offense was a proximate cause of a traffic-related death, shall be guilty of a Class E 13 14 felony." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to 15
