5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 128-21(10) reads as rewritten:
6	"(10) "Employee" shall mean any person who is regularly employed in the
7	service of and whose salary or compensation is paid by the employer
8	as defined in subdivision (11) of this section, whether employed or
9	appointed employed, appointed, or elected for stated terms or
10	otherwise, except teachers in the public schools and except such
11	employees who hold office by popular election as are not required to
12	devote a major portion of their time to the duties of their office.
13	schools. "Employee" also means all full-time, paid firemen who are
14	employed by any fire department that serves a city or county or any
15	part of a city or county and that is supported in whole or in part by
16	municipal or county funds. In all cases of doubt the Board of Trustees
17	shall decide who is an employee. On and after August 1, 2001, a
18	person who is a nonimmigrant alien and who otherwise meets the
19	requirements of this subdivision shall not be excluded from the
20	definition of "employee" solely because the person holds a temporary
21	or time-limited visa."
22	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
