A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AGRICULTURAL SURVEYS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services the sum of two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for a rotating program to survey production and other important information related to aquaculture, turfgrass, equine, goats, Christmas trees, nursery and greenhouse, herbs, strawberries, forage and grassland, tomatoes and other vegetables, agritourism, organics, orchards, vineyards, and other specialty commodities.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
