May 9, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REPEAL THE GOVERNOR'S VISION CARE PROGRAM AND THE REQUIREMENT FOR A COMPREHENSIVE EYE EXAMINATION ENACTED UNDER THE GOVERNOR'S VISION CARE PROGRAM, AND TO PROVIDE THAT FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE RESERVE FOR THE GOVERNOR'S VISION CARE PROGRAM SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Section 10.59F of S.L. 2005-276 is repealed. **SECTION 2.** Funds in the Reserve for the Governor's Vision Care Program shall revert to the General Fund on June 30, 2006. **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
