2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO CONTINUE THE WORK OF THE  
3 NORTH CAROLINA INDIAN ECONOMIC INITIATIVE TO PROMOTE JOBS  
4 AND OTHER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OPTIONS FOR INDIAN  
5 COMMUNITIES.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
8 Department of Administration the sum of two hundred ten thousand dollars (\$210,000)  
9 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to promote long-term economic growth through the  
10 activities of the North Carolina Indian Economic Development Initiative. Funds will be  
11 used to provide business development services to entrepreneurs, to assist tribal  
12 organizations to develop their own business operations to produce revenue and jobs in  
13 rural communities, and to otherwise support the Initiative's economic development  
14 efforts.

15       **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
