2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3 HUMAN SERVICES TO ESTABLISH TEN ADDITIONAL LONG-TERM CARE
4 OMBUDSMAN POSITIONS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE STUDY
5 COMMISSION ON AGING.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
8 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of four hundred ninety-two
9 thousand one hundred thirty-six dollars (\$492,136) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the
10 salary, benefits, and travel for 10 additional Long-Term Care Ombudsman positions.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
