3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
4	SECTION 1. G.S. 95-25.3(a) reads as rewritten:
5	"(a) Every employer shall pay to each employee who in any workweek performs
6	any work, wages of at least six dollars and fifteen cents (\$6.15) per hour or the
7	minimum wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor Standards Act,
8	29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from time to time, whichever is higher,
9	except as otherwise provided in this section."
0	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 2007.
