A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL TEACHING FELLOWS
SCHOLARSHIPS.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Williams, Wilson, Womble, and Wray.

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 6 Department of Public Instruction the sum of six hundred fifty thousand dollars 7 (\$650,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one million three hundred 8 thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide for an additional 9 100 scholarships each year under the Teaching Fellows Program.

10 SECTION 2. It is the goal of the General Assembly to provide funds for an 11 additional 100 scholarships under the Teaching Fellows Program for the 2007-2008 12 fiscal year and an additional 100 scholarships for the 2008-2009 fiscal year.

13 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
