Short Title: Pave Unpaved Roads Outside City Limits. (Public) Representatives Rayfield; Capps, Cleveland, Coates, Culp, Frye, Sponsors: LaRoque, and Pate. Referred to: Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House. May 25, 2006 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PAVE ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ROAD, OR STREET THAT HAS BEEN PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM FOR MORE THAN THIRTY YEARS AND IS NOT WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF ANY MUNICIPALITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 136-102.6B. Pavement of roads more than 30 years old outside the corporate limits of a municipality. The Department of Transportation shall pave any public highway, road, or street that has been part of the county road system for more than 30 years and is not within the
