SECTION 1. The 2005 General Assembly, Regular Session 2006, may consider "A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO DETAIN INDIVIDUALS THEY REASONABLY BELIEVE TO BE UNDOCUMENTED ALIENS AT THE SCENE OF A CRIME OR A TRAFFIC CRASH AND TO TAKE THEM BEFORE A JUDICIAL OFFICIAL TO DETERMINE IF THEY ARE A RISK TO NATIONAL OR STATE SECURITY, OR TO AWAIT A DETERMINATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE, AS TO THE PERSON'S STATUS."
