A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A NEW ASSISTANT
DISTRICT ATTORNEY IN PROSECUTORIAL DISTRICT 15A.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-60(a1) reads as rewritten:

"(a1) The counties of the State are organized into prosecutorial districts, and each district has the counties and the number of full-time assistant district attorneys set forth in the following table:

SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of eighty-two thousand two hundred fifty-three dollars (\$82,253) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-seven thousand five hundred ninety-two dollars (\$77,592) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish the new assistant district attorney authorized by this act.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
