A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO ESTABLISH AN ASSISTANT COUNTY 3 RANGER POSITION IN THE DIVISION OF FOREST RESOURCES TO BE 4 ASSIGNED TO COLUMBUS COUNTY. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North 6 7 Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Forest 8 Resources, the sum of fourteen thousand eight hundred seventy dollars (\$14,870) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of fourteen thousand four hundred fifty dollars 9 (\$14,450) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish a new, full-time Forest Technician I 10 (Assistant County Ranger) position assigned to Columbus County, including salary and 11 other support costs associated with the position. 12 **SECTION 2.** The State funding for the seasonal position of Smoke Chaser 13 14 in Columbus County, in the amount of ten thousand four hundred twenty-six dollars (\$10,426), shall be transferred to fund the new position established by this act. State 15 funding shall account for sixty percent (60%) of the costs of the new position. The 16 County of Columbus shall fund the remaining forty percent (40%) of the costs. 17 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005. 18
