A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES WILL
REPLACE STOLEN REGISTRATION PLATES WITHOUT PAYMENT OF A
FEE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-68(a) reads as rewritten:

"§ 20-68. Replacement of lost or damaged certificates, cards and plates.

(a) ~~In the event any~~ If a registration card or registration plate is lost, mutilated, or becomes illegible, the owner or legal representative of the owner of the vehicle for which ~~the same~~ it was issued, as shown by the ~~records of the Division, Division's records,~~ shall immediately ~~make application~~ apply for and ~~may~~ obtain a duplicate or a substitute or a new registration under a new registration ~~number, number,~~ as determined by the Division, by supplying any required sworn information and paying the appropriate fee. as determined to be most advisable by the Division, upon the applicant's ~~furnishing under oath information satisfactory to the Division and payment of required fee.~~ If a registration plate is stolen and the applicant furnishes any sworn information about the theft that is required by the Division, the registration plate shall be replaced without payment of a fee."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
