HOUSE DRH60254-LL-124 (3/10) Short Title: Currituck Bear Hunting. (Local) Sponsors: Representative Owens. Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ADD CURRITUCK COUNTY TO THOSE COUNTIES WITH AN EXTENDED BEAR HUNTING SEASON. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Chapter 220 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 39 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten: "Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the season for hunting black bear shall run from the Friday and Saturday prior to the date established by the Wildlife Resources Commission as the start of bear season until the date established by the Wildlife Resources Commission as the end of bear season. Sec. 2. This act applies only to Pasquotank, Camden, and Chowan Chowan, and Currituck counties.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification."
