The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Each district court district shall have the numbers of judges as set forth in the following table:

42 **SECTION 2.** The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judges
 43 for District 10 authorized by this act, and those judges' successors shall be elected in the

1 2006 general election for four-year terms commencing on the first Monday in December
2 2006.

3 **SECTION 3.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial
4 Department the sum of two hundred thirteen thousand five hundred seventy-six dollars
5 (\$213,576) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty-one thousand
6 eight hundred twenty-four dollars (\$251,824) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to establish
7 the two new district court judges for District Court District 10 authorized by this act.

8 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2005.
