The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. Chapter 145 of the General Statutes is amended by	adding a
new section to read:	
"§ 145-22. State carnivorous plant.	
The Venus flytrap (Dionaea muscipula) is adopted as the official carnivor	ous plant
of the State of North Carolina."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
