13		<u>(b)</u>	Odd-numbered years Beginning with the regular session in 2007,		
14			during an odd-numbered year, the General Assembly shall remain in		
15			session for no more than 135 calendar days, except that this period		
16			may be extended by joint resolution once per regular session for not		
17			more than 10 calendar days. The month of December beginning on the		
18			first Wednesday in the month in each preceding even-numbered year is		
19			also included in the calculation of the limit of days the General		
20			Assembly may meet in odd-numbered years. If the General Assembly,		
21			upon convening of the regular session, meets initially for not more		
22			than two consecutive calendar days and then adjourns for not less than		
23			30 calendar days, that period of adjournment shall be excluded from		
24			the 135 calendar days.
