A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL
RESOURCES TO DEVELOP A COST-SHARE PROGRAM TO ASSIST
GROWERS IN FUNDING ANIMAL WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS AT
SWINE FARMS THAT MEET CERTAIN STANDARDS AND THAT REPLACE
SYSTEMS EMPLOYING ANAEROBIC LAGOONS AND TO APPROPRIATE
FUNDS FOR THIS PROGRAM.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** Beginning no later than October 1, 2006, the Department of 10 Environment and Natural Resources shall develop and implement a cost-share program 11 to provide financial and technical assistance to qualifying growers who volunteer to replace any existing anaerobic lagoon that is a primary component of an animal waste 12 management system with an animal waste management system that meets all of the 13 14 standards set forth in either subdivision (7) or subdivision (8) of subsection (b) of Section 1.1 of S.L. 1997-458, as amended by Section 2 of S.L. 1998-188. 15 The 16 Department may contract as needed with third-party waste management companies for 17 the transport, management, or treatment of waste produced on swine farms participating 18 in this cost-share program.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources shall establish a steering committee to advise it on technology and farm site selection and other criteria under the cost-share program under this act and to assist in evaluating the program's performance. The steering committee shall include at least one member who represents each of the following: a grower, a scientist, an agricultural economist, a representative of a conservation group, a representative of a community group, and a representative of the pork industry.

SECTION 3. The Department of Environment and Natural Resources may receive and spend any funds received from private, federal, and other public sources for the costs of the cost-share program under this act and may adopt rules necessary to implement this program.

| 7 | (2) Animal waste management system. – Defined in G.S. 143-215.10B. |
| 8 | (3) Grower. – Defined in G.S. 143-215.10H. |
| 9 | (4) Swine farm. – Defined in G.S. 106-802. |
| 10 | SECTION 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the |
| 11 | Department of Environment and Natural Resources the sum of five million dollars |
| 12 | (\$5,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the costs of implementing this act and for |
| 13 | cost-share funds for growers participating in the cost-share program under this act. |
| 14 | SECTION 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006. |
