4	Whereas, thousands of men and women have proudly served in the United
5	States Marine Corps; and
6	Whereas, many of these men and women have trained at Camp Lejeune and
7	Marine Corps Air Station New River in Onslow County; and
8	Whereas, the locations of these training facilities have been beneficial to
9	Onslow County and the surrounding areas, generating millions of dollars for the
10	community and attracting new residents and businesses; and
11	Whereas, there is strong community support in Onslow County in
12	establishing the Onslow Vietnam Veterans Memorial; and
13	Whereas, plans have been made to locate the Onslow Vietnam Veterans
14	Memorial with the Beirut Memorial in the Lejeune Memorial Gardens at Camp
15	Lejeune, North Carolina; and
16	Whereas, the present Beirut Memorial draws an average of 4,000 visitors per
17	year and generates more than \$400,000 into the local economy; and
18	Whereas, the addition of the Onslow Vietnam Veterans Memorial would
19	increase visitors by 2,500 per year with a \$250,000 increase in tourism spending; and
20	Whereas, the Onslow Vietnam Veterans Memorial will feature the names of
21	the 58,229 men and women who died in the Vietnam War while serving in the armed
22	forces; and
23	Whereas, the Onslow Vietnam Veterans Memorial will provide a place of
24	solitude for visitors to remember their loved ones and for Marines to remember those
25	gone before them; Now, therefore,

General Assembly of North Carolina

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Onslow 2 Vietnam Veterans Memorial Foundation, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of one 3 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to 4 assist with the construction of a memorial to honor the men and women who have 5 served during the Vietnam era in the armed forces of the United States. 6 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
