A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING ASHE COUNTY TO USE WIND-POWERED ELECTRICITY GENERATION PROJECTS ON MOUNTAIN RIDGES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 113A-206 reads as rewritten: "§ 113A-206. Definitions. Within the meaning of this Article:		
"Tall buildings or structures" include any building, structure or un within a multiunit building with a vertical height of more than 40 fe measured from the top of the foundation of said building, structure unit and the uppermost point of said building, structure or un provided, however, that where such foundation measured from the natural finished grade of the crest or the natural finished grade of the high side of the slope of a ridge exceeds 3 feet, then such measureme in excess of 3 feet shall be included in the 40-foot limitation describe herein; provided, further, that no such building, structure or unit shap protrude at its uppermost point above the crest of the ridge by most than 35 feet.
