6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-47(29a) reads as rewritten:
8	"§ 115C-47. Powers and duties generally.
9	In addition to the powers and duties designated in G.S. 115C-36, local boards of
10	education shall have the power or duty:
11	
12	(29a) To Encourage Require the Display of the United States and North
13	Carolina Flags, and to Encourage Require the Recitation of the Pledge
14	or Oath of Allegiance. – Local boards of education are encouraged to
15	shall adopt policies to (i) provide for require the display of the United
16	States and North Carolina flags in each classroom, when available, (ii)
17	provide the opportunity for students to recite the Pledge or Oath of
18	Allegiance on a regular basis, require that recitation of the Pledge or
19	Oath of Allegiance be scheduled on a daily basis, and (iii) provide
20	age-appropriate instruction on the meaning and historical origins of the
21	flag and the Pledge of Allegiance. These policies shall not compel any
22	person to stand, salute the flag, or recite the Pledge of Allegiance. If
23	flags are donated or are otherwise available, flags shall be displayed in
24	each classroom."
25	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
