8	<u>(a)</u>	Notwithstanding G.S. 143-18 or any other provision of law:
9		(1) If all of the counties in the service area of a community college are
10		low-wealth counties, the community college may retain and carry
11		forward its General Fund current operations credit balance remaining
12		at the end of the fiscal year.
13		(2) If one or more of the counties in the service area of a community
14		college are low-wealth counties, the community college may retain
15		and carry forward the percentage of its General Fund current
16		operations credit balance authorized by G.S. 115D-31.3(g). Of the
17		remainder of the General Fund current operations credit balance
18		remaining at the end of the fiscal year, the college may carry forward a
19		percentage of that amount equal to the percentage of the college's
20		maintenance of plant funds that are provided by the low-wealth
21		counties in its service area.
22	<u>(b)</u>	As used in this section, a low-wealth community county is a county in which
23	the school	ols are eligible to receive low-wealth school supplemental funding for the fiscal
24	<u>year.</u> "	
25		SECTION 2. This act becomes effective June 30, 2005.
