 - (c) The Authority shall adopt rules to implement this section."

SECTION 2. There shall be a separate early registration period for in-State students for the Paramedic-to-BSN Program offered at Tri-County Community College by Winston-Salem State University to ensure that no out-of-state student displaces an in-State student in the Program.

SECTION 3. Winston-Salem State University and Tri-County Community College shall thoroughly evaluate the effects of the scholarship loans in this act on the production, retention, and utilization of registered nurses in the State. They shall report their findings and their recommendation on continuing the scholarship loans to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina and the State Board of Community Colleges prior to January 1, 2009.

SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires July 31, 2009. Students who enter the Paramedic-to-BSN Program offered at Tri-County Community College by Winston-Salem State University or enter the Program at Winston-Salem State University prior to July 31, 2009, shall continue to receive the scholarship loans while attending the Program so long as they remain in good standing in the Paramedic-to-BSN Program and comply with the criteria established under G.S. 116-209.34 for the Program.
