SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Commerce, Division of Community Assistance, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to study and establish pilot programs for the shared provision of local government services, including:

- (1) Regional jails.
- (2) Regional animal shelters and consolidated animal control services.
- 12 (3) Consolidated payroll services.
- 13 (4) Any other appropriate function that may be coordinated under an interlocal agreement or through consolidated efforts.
- The Division of Community Assistance shall implement three pilots. The pilots shall be geographically located to cover the western, central, and eastern parts of the State.
 - **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
