March 27, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO JUSTICE BY 3 INCREASING THE HOURLY RATE FOR ATTORNEYS APPOINTED TO 4 REPRESENT INDIGENT PERSONS. 5 Whereas, attorneys appointed to represent indigent defendants and 6 respondents are critical components of a fair and effective justice system; and Whereas, the General Assembly has given the Commission on Indigent 7 8 Defense Services ("IDS") the statutory authority to set compensation rates for attorneys 9 appointed to represent indigent persons; and Whereas, in 2002, IDS established the current rate of \$65.00 per hour for 10 11 noncapital cases; and 12 Whereas, State and national surveys indicates that current overhead operating 13 costs of a law practice range between \$51.00 and \$65.00 per hour and that those 14 overhead costs are paid by private attorneys out of the \$65.00 per hour IDS rate they 15 earn: and Whereas, the salaries of State employees, including defenders, prosecutors, 16 17 judges, and other court system employees, have increased by 10.2% since IDS was 18 established and 7.5% in the last two years alone, but the noncapital \$65.00 per hour rate 19 has remained the same: and 20 Whereas, IDS has insufficient funds to raise the hourly rate without an 21 increased appropriation; and 22 Whereas, a \$10.00 increase in the noncapital IDS rate will strengthen the 23 effectiveness and fairness of our justice system for all North Carolinians; Now, 24 therefore. 25 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

26 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of 27 Indigent Defense Services the sum of eight million five hundred forty-one thousand five

hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$8,541,528) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of 1 2 eight million nine hundred ninety-four thousand two hundred twenty-eight dollars 3 (\$8,994,228) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund an increase by the Commission on 4 Indigent Defense Services of the noncapital hourly rate paid to attorneys appointed to 5 represent indigent persons from sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) per hour to seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per hour. 6 7

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
