2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE WESTERN NORTH
3	CAROLINA REGION COALITION FOR SAFE AND DRUG-FREE
4	COMMUNITIES PROJECT.
5	Whereas, the Western North Carolina Region Coalition for Safe and
6	Drug-Free Communities provides the school system in each of the seven western North
7	Carolina counties with the resources necessary to introduce substance abuse prevention
8	in all grades; and
9	Whereas, the Coalition collaborates with other coalitions and communities to
10	establish assistance for prevention, intervention, and education about substance abuse
11	and makes those resources known throughout the region; and
12	Whereas, the Coalition provides individual coalitions with parents, schools,
13	and citizens to increase awareness about alcohol, tobacco, drug abuse, and other topics
14	regarding the reduction of unsafe conditions in our local communities; and
15	Whereas, the Coalition provides information and guidance to churches and
16	other nonprofit organizations in neighboring communities about how to establish
17	coalitions to promote safe and drug-free communities; Now, therefore,
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
19	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Hinton
20	Rural Life Center, Inc., a nonprofit organization, five hundred thousand dollars
21	(\$500,000) for support of the organization's Western North Carolina Region Coalition
22	for a Safe and Drug-Free Communities Project for Cherokee, Graham, Haywood,
23	Jackson, Macon, Swain, and Clay Counties. These funds shall also be used to expand
24	the operations of the Western North Carolina Region Coalition for Safe and Drug-Free
25	Communities Project into Transylvania County.
26	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
