5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The title of Chapter 115B of the General Statutes reads as
7	rewritten:
8	"Chapter 115B.
9	Tuition and Fee Waivers."
10	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Chapter 115B of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
11	new section to read:
12	" <u>§ 115B-2A. Fee waiver authorized.</u>
13	The constituent institutions of The University of North Carolina and the community
14	colleges as defined in G.S. 115D-2(2) shall permit any person to attend classes for up to
15	six hours of credit or noncredit purposes each academic semester without the required
16	payment of fees, excluding textbooks, the community colleges computer use and
17	technology fee, and community college course specific fees, if the person has attained
18	the age of 65 and qualifies as a legal resident of North Carolina and as a resident for
19	tuition purposes in accordance with definitions of residency that may from time to time
20	be adopted by the Board of Governors and published in the residency manual of the
21	Board of Governors."

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective August 1, 2008, and applies to classes for any academic semester beginning on or after that date.
