A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT CLARIFYING THAT CUMBERLAND COUNTY MAY CHARGE FEES
2 TO OPERATE AND ENFORCE A STORMWATER CONTROL OR
3 MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 153A-454(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) A county may adopt and enforce a stormwater control ordinance to protect
8 water quality and control water quantity. A county may adopt a stormwater
9 management ordinance pursuant to this Chapter, other applicable laws, or any
10 combination of these powers. A county may establish and revise, in accordance with
11 G.S. 153A-277, from time to time schedules of rates, fees, charges, and penalties for the
12 operation and enforcement of stormwater control or management ordinances."

13 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to Cumberland County only.

14 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
