A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO SUPPORT ONE HUNDRED BLACK
MEN OF AMERICA-TRIANGLE EAST CHAPTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to 100 Black Men of America-Triangle East Chapter, a nonprofit organization, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for operating expenses incurred in providing programs designed to improve the quality of life and enhance the educational and economic opportunities for young men in the City of Raleigh and the surrounding Research Triangle area.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
