The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be allocated to Triangle Residential Options for Substance Abusers (TROSA), a nonprofit, State-licensed therapeutic community. These funds shall be used to expand services to include additional individualized counseling and group therapeutic services for 60 individuals in the program.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
