 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE THAT HAS A SCHOOL BUS ENDORSEMENT TO EXPIRE THREE YEARS AFTER IT IS ISSUED. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 20-7(f)(2) reads as rewritten: "(f) Duration and Renewal of Licenses. – Drivers licenses shall be issued and renewed pursuant to the provisions of this subsection. 	
	Duration of license for persons at least 18 years of age or older. – A drivers license issued to a person at least 18 years old but less than 54 years old expires eight years after the date of issuance. A drivers license issued to a person at least 54 years old expires five years after the date of issuance. A commercial drivers license that has a vehicles carrying passengers (P) and school bus (S) endorsement issued pursuant to G.S. 20-37.16 shall expire on the birth date of the licensee three years after the date of issuance, if the licensee is certified to drive a school bus in North Carolina.
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
