| 8 | A taxpayer that purchases and installs equipment to convert used vegetable oil into |
| 9 | fuel is allowed a credit equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the cost of purchasing and |
| 10 | installing the equipment. A taxpayer that claims a credit under this section may not |
| 11 | claim a credit under G.S. 105-129.16A, 105-129.16D, or 105-129.16F with respect to |
| 12 | the same property. This section is repealed for taxable years beginning on or after |
| 13 | January 1, 2011." |
