A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE JUVENILE CRIME PREVENTION COUNCILS FOR THE COUNCILS' PROGRAMS ON A RECURRING BASIS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: <b>SECTION 1.</b> Of the funds appropriated to the Department of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, the sum of six hundred sixty thousand six hundred twenty-four dollars (\$660,624) shall be allocated to the Juvenile Crime Prevention Councils serving Franklin, Granville, Person, Vance, and Granville Counties. <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
