A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE WOMEN AT RISK PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to continue funding for Women at Risk at the same level as that provided in the 2007-2008 budget. Women at Risk is a community-based treatment program serving female offenders at risk of incarceration and their families.

**SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to provide additional funding for Women at Risk to expand substance abuse and mental health treatment to more at-risk female offenders in 10 targeted Western North Carolina counties: Buncombe, Henderson, McDowell, Rutherford, Yancey, Madison, Haywood, Jackson, Transylvania, and Polk.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
