2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO JONES COUNTY TO EXTEND SEWER  
3 LINES TO SCHOOLS WITH SEPTIC SYSTEMS IN THE TOWN OF TRENTON.

4       Whereas, the elementary and middle schools in the Town of Trenton continue  
5 to use septic tanks; and

6       Whereas, storms have often led to sewage overflow, causing these schools to  
7 close and prompting health concerns for students and school personnel; and

8       Whereas, the Jones County Commissioners and the School Board support the  
9 installation of sewer lines to these schools; Now, therefore,

10 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

11       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Jones County  
12 the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to extend  
13 sewer lines to the schools in the Town of Trenton that are currently using septic tanks.

14       **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
