close and prompting health concerns for students and school personnel; and

installation of sewer lines to these schools; Now, therefore,		
The General	l Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
$\mathbf{S}$	ECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Jon	es County
the sum of	one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year	to extend
sewer lines t	to the schools in the Town of Trenton that are currently using sept	ic tanks.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
