A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO EXEMPT BUSES FROM SAFETY INSPECTIONS REQUIRED UNDER MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS IF THEY ARE TITLED TO A LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY AND SUBJECT TO SCHOOL BUS INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.
