A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO REGULATE OR PROHIBIT NEW IRRIGATION SYSTEMS FOR RESIDENTIAL AND NONRESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENTS USED FOR LAWNS AND LANDSCAPING THAT ARE CONNECTED TO THE PUBLIC POTABLE WATER SUPPLY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. A municipality may by ordinance regulate or prohibit, in new subdivisions and other residential and nonresidential development, irrigation systems for lawns and other landscaping which are connected to the local potable water supply system.

SECTION 2. This act applies to the Town of Chapel Hill only.

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
