A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE CERTAIN RETAILERS IN THE STATE TO IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM TO RECYCLE THE PLASTIC BAGS PROVIDED TO CUSTOMERS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 130A-309.10(c) reads as rewritten:
