A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE CRAVEN COUNTY REGIONAL  
2 AIRPORT AUTHORITY, TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE CRAVEN  
3 COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT, AND TO ADD EX OFFICIO MEMBERS TO  
4 THE AIRPORT AUTHORITY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.(a)** Sections 1 and 7 of S.L. 1979-1197, as amended by Section  
8 1.1 of S.L. 1989-1046, is amended by deleting "Craven County Regional Airport  
9 Authority" and substituting "Coastal Carolina Regional Airport Authority."

10 **SECTION 1.(b)**. S.L. 1979-1197, as amended by Section 1.2 of S.L.  
11 1989-1046, is amended by deleting "Craven County Regional Airport," wherever that  
12 phrase appears, and substituting "Coastal Carolina Regional Airport."

13 **SECTION 1.(c)**. Section 2(a) of S.L. 1979-1197, as rewritten by Section  
14 1(a) of S.L. 2005-14, reads as rewritten:

15 "(a) The Airport Authority shall consist of eight voting members, all of whom  
16 shall be residents of Craven County. The Commanding ~~General Officer~~ of the United  
17 States Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, North Carolina, or the ~~General's~~  
18 Commanding Officer's designee may serve as a nonvoting ~~Honorary Ex Officio~~  
19 Member of the Authority. Further, the Board of Commissioners of Jones County may  
20 appoint a nonvoting Ex Officio Member to serve on the Airport Authority, the Board of  
21 Commissioners of Pamlico County may appoint a nonvoting Ex Officio Member to  
22 serve on the Airport Authority, and the Board of Commissioners of Carteret County  
23 may appoint a nonvoting Ex Officio Member to serve on the Airport Authority. Five  
24 voting members of the Airport Authority shall constitute a quorum."

25 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
