1 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A NONCITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES WHO IS 3 PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES TO PRESENT A VALID PASSPORT 4 FROM THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND VALID DOCUMENTATION 5 SHOWING LEGAL PRESENCE ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES 6 GOVERNMENT TO RECEIVE A DRIVERS LICENSE FROM THE DIVISION 7 OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR 8 VEHICLES TO VERIFY SOCIAL SECURITY DOCUMENTATION. 9 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 10 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-7(b1) reads as rewritten: "§ 20-7. Issuance and renewal of drivers licenses. 11 12 Application. - To obtain an identification card, learners permit, or drivers 13 (b1) 14 license from the Division, a person shall complete an application form provided by the Division, present at least two forms of identification approved by the Commissioner, be 15 a resident of this State, and, except for an identification card, demonstrate his or her 16 physical and mental ability to drive safely a motor vehicle included in the class of

17 license for which the person has applied. At least one of the forms of identification shall 18 19 indicate the applicant's residence address. The Division may copy the identification 20 presented or hold it for a brief period of time to verify its authenticity. To obtain an 21 endorsement, a person shall demonstrate his or her physical and mental ability to drive 22 safely the type of motor vehicle for which the endorsement is required.

23 The application form shall request all of the following information, and it shall 24 contain the disclosures concerning the request for an applicant's social security number 25 required by section 7 of the federal Privacy Act of 1974, Pub. L. No. 93-579:
